Upon the roll call, the following Trustees were present: Trustees White, Milenkovic, Torres, Kapolnek and Hrejsa Absent: Trustee Savopoulos

Trustee Torres moved, duly seconded by Trustee Kapolnek to approve the minutes of the regular board meeting held on Tuesday, March 21, 2023.

Mayor Walik declared the motion carried.

Prior to the vote, Mayor Walik explained that we need to amend the time of the block party. The requester asked for 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m. The Block Party rules only allow the time of 10:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. The board agreed with the Mayor's request.

MAYOR'S REPORT: The Mayor apologized for missing the last board meeting due to bad pneumonia. Trustee Savopoulos had some minor back surgery and will be back soon. The Mayor gave the Unofficial results if the April 4, 2023 Consolidated Election for the Village Independent Party, Jeffery White 256, 34.88%; Mitchell Milenkovic 240, 32.70%; James Hrejsa 238, 32.43%; The clerk added that the total was actually one half of the total from the election in 2019. It was a poor voter turnout. The Official

results will be ready for the May 2, 2023 board meeting. The Mayor commented on the amazing response to the Easter Egg Hunt. We were reminded that the May 2, 2023 Board Meeting will be held at Saint Pius Church hall. The attorney asked that notices be given to inform people of the change a substantial time prior to the meeting. The TIF meeting will be held at 6:00 p.m. and the Board meeting will be at 7:00 p.m. The clerk informed people of the legal notice is being published in the *Life Newspaper*. The attorney explained that we are anticipating a large crowd for the TIF. Having it in a larger venue will eliminate having to reschedule the meeting because of the size of the crowd. The newsletter went out.

<u>CLERK'S REPORT:</u> The Clerk reminded people that she will have the Certified count of the election for the May 2 meeting. There is a resolution that will be voted upon. The newly elected Trustees will be sworn in on that day. There also might be the appropriation budget on that day.

## TRUSTEE REPORTS

TRUSTEE HREJSA: He thanked all the people who helped and volunteered for the Easter Egg Hunt. A preparation meeting will take place for the Cinco De Mayo Fest.

Trustee Kapolnek: He informed us that the Stickney newsletter is on the website.

TRUSTEE TORRES: We were told that there were over three hundred kids at the Easter Egg Hunt. She is planning the Cinco De Mayo festivities on April 30, 2023 from 2:00 – 7:00 p.m. It is located at 43<sup>rd</sup> and Ridgeland. An outline of the activities was given. There will be raffle prizes. The Morton College nurses will be taking blood pressure checks. It is open to everyone.

<u>Trustee Milenkovic:</u> The Tree Board and Trustee Hrejsa joined forces to prepare for Arbor Day. The celebration will be on Friday, April 28, 2023. We do this every year to keep our Tree City status.

#### **DEPARTMENT REPORTS:**

<u>Police Chief Sassetti:</u> During the month of April pursuant to the Illinois Department of Transportation Step Grant, the Stickney Police Department will have extra officers on the street as part of the "Drop and Drive" campaign. The primary focus will be trying to find violators on their phones or texting while driving. You will see an increased police presence on the street during the month of April for this purpose.

Fire Chief Jeff Boyajian: He asked people to have a safe Easter.

<u>Public Works Assistant Director Sam Alonzo:</u> Street sweeping has begun. He asked people to respect parking restrictions. The Mayor mentioned that people have contacted him to thank him for cleaning the alleys.

## **ORDINANCE NO. 2023-05**

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 14, SECTION 14-148 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE, VILLAGE OF STICKNEY, ILLINOIS REGARDING RESIDENTIAL PARKING ZONES.

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Stickney (the "Village") is a home rule municipal corporation in accordance with Article VII, Section 6(a) of the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village has the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs, and to review, interpret and amend its ordinances, rules and regulations; and

**WHEREAS,** the Village President (the "President") and the Board of Trustees of the Village (the "Village Board" and with the President, the "Corporate Authorities") are committed to ensuring the health, safety and welfare of Village residents; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have determined that Chapter 14, Section 14-148 of the Municipal Code, Village of Stickney (the "Village Code") regarding the hours for parking during street cleaning operations should be amended to clarify parking regulations on certain streets during the specified hours; and

**WHEREAS**, parking and regulation and enforcement of same is a valid exercise of the police powers held by the Village; and

**WHEREAS**, the Corporate Authorities desire to exercise their home rule authority in implementing the regulations contemplated herein (the "Regulations"); and

**WHEREAS**, based upon the foregoing, the Corporate Authorities have determined that it is necessary, advisable and in the best interests of the Village and its residents to amend Chapter 14, Section 14-148 of the Village Code related to the hours for parking during street cleaning operations, as set forth below;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF STICKNEY, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

## ARTICLE I. IN GENERAL

#### SECTION 1. INCORPORATION CLAUSE.

The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are full, true and correct and do hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this Ordinance as legislative findings.

#### SECTION 2. PURPOSE.

The purpose of this Ordinance is to amend Chapter 14, Section 14-148 of the Village Code related to the hours for parking during street cleaning operations as provided for herein and to authorize the President or his designee to take all action necessary to carry out the intent of this Ordinance.

# ARTICLE II. AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 14, SECTION 14-148 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE, VILLAGE OF STICKNEY, ILLINOIS

## SECTION 3.0. AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 14, SECTION 14-148.

That the Village Code is hereby amended, notwithstanding any provision, ordinance, resolution or Village Code section to the contrary, by amending Chapter 14, Section 14-148 as follows:

## Sec. 14-148. – Parking during street cleaning operations.

- (a) It shall be unlawful to park any vehicle on any public street or portion thereof in the village at any time from April 1 to November 30, when such streets are being cleaned as follows:
  - (1) On Mondays between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.
    - a. On the north side of all streets and public thoroughfares extending in a general easterly and westerly direction; and
    - b. On the west side of all streets and public thoroughfares extending in a generally northerly and southerly direction.
  - (2) On Tuesdays between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.
    - a. On the south side of all streets and public thoroughfares extending in a generally easterly and westerly direction; and
    - b. On the east side of all street and public thoroughfares extending in a generally northerly and southerly direction.
  - (3) Monday-Friday between 8:00 a.m. and 11:30 a.m.
    - a. On all streets and public through fares in the 4100 and 4200 blocks of East Ave; and
    - b. On all streets and public through fares in the 7000 and 7100 blocks of 40th Place.
- (b) It shall be unlawful to park any vehicle on Pershing Road or portion thereof in the village at any time from April 1, through November 30 when Pershing Road is being cleaned as follows:
  - (1) On Fridays between 5:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m.
- (c) When snowfall measures two inches or more, the snow removal regulations will supersede the street sweeping regulations.
- (d) Vehicles parked in violation of this section may be towed or relocated by the village or removed and towed away by a commercial towing service. The village shall give notice to the registered owner of the vehicles that the vehicle was towed or relocated within three business days of the relocation, removal, or tow. Said notice shall be served

by registered or certified mail, or personal delivery. The registered owner of any towed vehicle shall be responsible for payment of an administrative cost of \$5.00 in addition to any and all storage costs and fees charged by the commercial towing service and any costs, judgments or bonds required by section 14-163.

#### SECTION 3.3. OTHER ACTIONS AUTHORIZED.

The officers, employees and/or agents of the Village shall take all action necessary or reasonably required to carry out, give effect to and consummate the amendments contemplated by this Ordinance, and shall take all action necessary in conformity therewith. The officers, employees and/or agents of the Village are specifically authorized and directed to draft and disseminate any and all necessary forms or notices to be utilized in connection with the intent of this Ordinance.

# ARTICLE III. HEADINGS, SAVINGS CLAUSES, PUBLICATION, EFFECTIVE DATE

## SECTION 4. HEADINGS.

The headings of the articles, sections, paragraphs and subparagraphs of this Ordinance are inserted solely for the convenience of reference and form no substantive part of this Ordinance nor should they be used in any interpretation or construction of any substantive provision of this Ordinance.

## SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY.

The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and should any provision of this Ordinance be determined to be in conflict with any law, statute or regulation by a court of competent jurisdiction, said provision shall be excluded and deemed inoperative, unenforceable and as though not provided for herein and all other provisions shall remain unaffected, unimpaired, valid and in full force and effect.

## SECTION 6. SUPERSEDER.

All code provisions, ordinances, resolutions, rules and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby superseded.

## SECTION 7. PUBLICATION.

A full, true and complete copy of this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form or in a newspaper published and of general circulation within the Village as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended.

#### SECTION 8. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage.

## **ORDINANCE NO. 2023-06**

- AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF A CERTAIN VEHICLE FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THE VILLAGE OF STICKNEY, ILLINOIS.
- WHEREAS, the Village of Stickney (the "Village") is a home rule municipal corporation in accordance with Article VII, Section 6(a) of the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Village has the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs, and to review, interpret and amend its ordinances, rules and regulations; and
- WHEREAS, the Village has determined that the Police Department is in need of one (1) Ford Police Interceptor (the "Vehicle") from Sutton Ford, Inc. as set forth in the invoice ("Invoice"), attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A; and
- WHEREAS, the Village President (the "President") and the Board of Trustees of the Village (the "Board" and with the President, the "Corporate Authorities") deem it advisable and necessary for the efficient operation of the Village and to purchase the Vehicle; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Corporate Authorities have determined that it is necessary, advisable, and in the best interests of the Village and its residents to take all steps necessary to purchase the Vehicle in accordance with the terms of the Invoice:
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF STICKNEY, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:
- **SECTION 1: RECITALS.** The facts and statements contained in the preamble to this Ordinance are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted as part of this Ordinance.
- **SECTION 2: PURPOSE.** The purpose of this Ordinance is to authorize the purchase of the Vehicle in accordance with the terms of the Invoice, and to authorize the President or his designee to take all necessary steps to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance.
- **SECTION 3: AUTHORIZATION.** The Board hereby authorizes the purchase of the Vehicle in accordance with the terms of the Invoice; waives any bidding requirements related to the purchase of the Vehicle; authorizes and directs the President or his designee to execute any and all necessary documentation to effectuate the same, with such insertions, omissions and

changes as shall be approved by the President and the Village Attorney; and ratifies any additional actions taken to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance. The Board further authorizes the President or his designee to execute any and all additional documentation that may be necessary to carry out the intent of this Ordinance. The Village Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to attest to and countersign any documentation as may be necessary to carry out and effectuate the purpose of this Ordinance. The Village Clerk is also authorized and directed to affix the Seal of the Village to such documentation as is deemed necessary. To the extent that any requirement of bidding would be applicable to the Vehicle described herein, the same is hereby waived.

**SECTION 4. HEADINGS.** The headings of the articles, sections, paragraphs and subparagraphs of this Ordinance are inserted solely for the convenience of reference and form no substantive part of this Ordinance nor should they be used in any interpretation or construction of any substantive provision of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY.** The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and should any provision of this Ordinance be determined to be in conflict with any law, statute or regulation by a court of competent jurisdiction, said provision shall be excluded and deemed inoperative, unenforceable and as though not provided for herein and all other provisions shall remain unaffected, unimpaired, valid and in full force and effect.

**SECTION 6. SUPERSEDER.** All code provisions, ordinances, resolutions, rules and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby superseded.

**SECTION 7. PUBLICATION.** A full, true and complete copy of this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form or in a newspaper published and of general circulation within the Village as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code, as amended.

**SECTION 8. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Ordinance shall be effective and in full force immediately upon passage and approval as provided by law.
