Good Afternoon,

Cook County Emergency Management and Regional Security (EMRS) is requesting your assistance in compiling damage reports from the storms that impacted our communities across Cook County on July 25th through July 28th. The goal is to collect reports of damage and track all costs expended by individuals in responding to and recovering from the storms. The information supplied will help determine if and how Cook County Emergency Management and Regional Security can pursue any options for assistance. Please note that submission of information does not constitute or guarantee county, state, or federal assistance.

EMRS is collaborating with the Illinois Emergency Management Agency (IEMA) and the City of Chicago Office of Emergency Management and Communications (OEMC) to gather information on damage incurred during storms. This information will help determine the scope of the damage and eligibility for any assistance. This does not need to be exact, and further documentation will be required to verify. Submitting this form does not guarantee assistance.



Reporting Storm Issues and Needs: Please notify EMRS if there are any unmet needs related to response and recovery in your community. In addition, contact the duty desk (312) 603-8185 or your regional coordinator with any questions you might have.

Information labeled F0U0 should be safeguarded and withheld from public release until approved for release by the originating agency.

Dissemination of F0U0 is restricted to persons with "need-to-know." Need-to-know is defined as the determination made by an authorized holder of information that a prospective recipient requires access to specific information in order to perform or assist in the lawful and authorized governmental function, i.e., access is required for the performance of official duties.

Typical F0U0 requirements include:

- 1. FOUO information will not be disseminated in any manner orally, visually, or electronically to unauthorized personnel.
- 2. The holder of the information will comply with access and dissemination restrictions.
- **3.** Ensure the recipient of FOUO has valid need-to-know, and that precautions are taken to prevent unauthorized individuals from overhearing the conversation, observing the materials, or otherwise obtaining the information.
