Prior to the vote the Mayor explained that this was basic housekeeping on Public Works. He thanked our Attorney Jessica Fese for putting it together. There is nothing new here. Just some cleanup work from years of being behind.

Trustee Torres moved, duly seconded by Trustee Hrejsa to Approve Resolution 01-2024, "A Resolution Authorizing and Approving a Governmental Relations Consulting Agreement With Amicus Government Strategies, LLC for the Village of Stickney"

Upon the roll call, the following Trustees voted:

Mayor Walik declared the motion carried.

MAYOR'S REPORT: He is thankful there is no snow. Many side jobs are being done like cleaning the sewers, cleaning along the fence line by the ball field and parks and the cemetery. Two of our department heads are ill today. He wished a Happy Birthday to Vivian Tabor who is 88 years old.

CLERK'S REPORT: She reminded people that voter registration closes for Deputy Registrars is February 27, 2024 for the Presidential Primary Election on March 19, 2024. The Early Voting schedule of times is available in the flyer located on the table in the lobby. She also provided the following information: On January 16, we had the pleasure of House Speaker Chris Welch visiting our Board meeting via ZOOM. He mentioned that he is a true advocate for the Village through and through with the Local Government Distributive Fund. It is called the LGDF. Since he has become the Speaker they have increased the amount of dollars that has been going into the LGDF. It helps the local municipalities do what they need to do. The Illinois Municipal League has provided the forecast LGDF amount estimate for Fiscal year 2024. It will be \$170.52. Going back to 2022 it was \$162.93. What we receive is based on our population.

The Mayor added that the Speaker of the House was at our last meeting. Then he referred to the video screens in the court room. In the future we will have the agenda displayed there and other things.

TRUSTEE REPORTS:

Trustee White: The students attending this meeting were told that they can come forward after the meeting and ask anyone on the Board to sign their assignment paper.

Trustee Milenkovic: He attended the Midway Noise Compatibility Commission last Thursday at 6:30 at the Mayfield Banquet facility on Archer. We meet four times per year. Our Public Works director mentioned that he felt that planes take off every 90 seconds. He asked Mitch to research this. The Trustee said that there are 622 operations per day. They average every 2 1/2 minutes. The most popular aircraft at Midway is the B737, with 416 operations per day. During the fourth quarter of 2023, the decibel level of noise was 52.1 decibels. During the fourth quarter of 2022 the decibel level was 50.7 We have a 2.6 decibel increase. The level where we would qualify for mediation is 65 decibels. We are way under that. Operations are near or better pre pandemic. At that time there was less traffic and therefore, less complaints. There were 1344 noise complaints during the fourth quarter of 2023. Zero of these complaints were from Stickney. Midway has a voluntary noise curfew where airlines are encouraged not to schedule flights between the hours of 12:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m.

Trustee Torres: The corned-beef dinner for the seniors will be in March. There will be the Easter Bunny event in March.

Trustee Kapolnek: We were reminded that February 19, is President's day. The Village and Public Works are closed that day. Garbage pickup will be backed up. The Early Voting information is on the Stickney website. There are other interesting articles posted there.

Trustee Torres: There are recreation plans in the works.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS: There were no reports.

Trustee White moved, duly seconded by Trustee Hrejsa to adjourn to Executive Session under Section 2 (2)(21) of the Open Meetings Act for discussion of minutes of meetings lawfully closed under this Act, whether for purposes for approval by the body of the minutes or semi-annual review of the minutes as mandated by Section 2.06

The Board of Trustees of the Village of Stickney met in Executive Session on Tuesday, July 18, 2023, at 8:08 p.m. in the Stickney Village Conference Room, 6533 W. Pershing Road, Stickney, Cook County, Illinois.

The Mayor called the meeting to order to review the closed session minutes.

The people in attendance were: Mayor Walik, Clerk McAdams and Village Attorney Jessica Fese, Trustees Hrejsa, Kapolnek, Milenkovic, Savopoulos, Torres and White; No non-members were at this meeting.

The clerk reminded those in attendance that they cannot disclose anything that has been discussed in a closed session. It is unethical. The clerk asked all in attendance to turn off their phones. Phone activity can be considered a meeting within a meeting. Your phone could be part of a FOIA request. All things heard are confidential. A reminder was given that it is unethical to disclose closed session activity.

The purpose of this meeting is to: At this point, the clerk turned the meeting over to Attorney Jessica Fese. "Discussion regarding the semi-annual review of minutes of meetings lawfully closed under the Open Meetings Act, (Consideration of This Matter Held In Closed Meeting/Executive Session Pursuant to 5 ILCS 120/2 (C) (21) (2017)." This is to be done semiannually. We have not done this in a few months. We are going into closed session to determine whether or not our minutes from previous closed sessions should be released and made public. She asked if there were any questions.

She went through a prepared memo in reverse from the DelGaldo Law Group. Anything before the February 7, 2017 meeting where there were several closed sessions minutes going back many years. Anything that was closed prior to 2017 will remain closed. Those [REDACTED] Anything that has been closed since 2017 we will keep it closed per her recommendations. Moving forward.
